## Student Competition 2024/24 Terms & Conditions

The organiser is **HARMAN technology Ltd**, Ilford Way, Mobberley, Cheshire, WA16 7JL

Entry is open to students of any age who are undertaking a full or part-time course at a school, college or university anywhere in the world. The competition is not open to employees of HARMAN technology, their families and relatives or anyone else connected with the competition.

The theme of the competition is "Pride & Prejudice, a reflection on the world today.", as described in the competition brief.

Entry is free and there is no limit to the number of entries permitted.

All prints entered must originate from ILFORD or Kentmere black and white film and be printed by you, (the competition entrant), in a darkroom on either ILFORD or Kentmere traditional black and white photographic papers.

Do not send negatives with prints. Negatives will be called for verification for all prints short-listed at the judging stage.

**Minimum entry size is 8x10". Any prints submitted on paper smaller than this will be automatically disqualified.**

**All prints entered must have a completed entry label stuck firmly on the reverse. Each print must have its own entry label.**

**There will be no exceptions to these rules.**

Images which have won any other competitions, or which have been published by a third party are not eligible for this competition.

The closing date for this competition is 31st January 2025. Entries must arrive on or before that date. HARMAN technology accepts no responsibility for any entries that are incomplete, illegible, or fail to reach the address given by the closing date. Proof of posting is not proof of receipt.

Winners will be notified within 1 month of the competition closing date.

All prints are submitted at the photographer's own risk and we are not able to return prints after the competition closes.

The organiser will appoint all judges, and the judges' decision is final and absolute. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the judges' decision.

The prizes are as shown on the competition brief. Prizes are not transferable and there is no cash alternative offered.
